

## **Minutes of Millfields Users Group Committee meeting 10 September 2014**

- Tree Circle Cinema this weekend. Discussed stewarding, tea/coffee, toilets for the event.
- Recent Steering Group meeting – attended by Harry, Will, new councillor Rebecca Rennison, Wendy, Silvera and Sam. Timber Play was the favourite option for the playground. The only paddling pool option on the table was to knock down the walls and paint the central bit. It was not popular.
