If budget does not allow, second option was a cheaper copy of the Barcelona style. Sam to come back to us on this.

We may have missed the event consultation due to old emails being used this should be corrected now through Sam & Nick Thompson. If the event is on next year, we'll consult and hopefully address the noise and size issues.
- 5. Park Lodge Sam said the next stage for the council was to get legal advice on the possible uses within the conditions use ancillary to the park. They would also do a survey to determine the condition of the building. We repeated we'd like to visit the building. It's going to take some time said Sam.
 - 6. The path in North Millfields is nearly finished. Sam said the paddling pool refurbishment (to a social space, not pool) should be under way and finished in about a month.
